

## Admission for Language Courses

Introduction. Bangladesh University of Professional (BUP) has started functioning from 06 June 2008 as 29th Public University of the country. Since its inception, the University has undertaken various efforts to establish itself as a standard competitive and reputed public University within the country. This university inherited a teaching department from Military institute of science and technology (MIST), an institution that was affiliated to Dhaka University. The inherited department is now functioning as faculty of business Studies (FBS). Presently, M Phil program on securities and strategic studies is being conducted by the National Defence college (NDC) for NDC graduates under BUP. Besides, BUP has under taken M Phil & Ph D program on Business Studies, Security Studies, Arts, Humanities and Social Science in this year under higher Education Quality Enhance project (HEQEP) by University Grants commission (UGC) financed by world bank. In the near future, BUP has also planned to conduct M Phil and Ph D program in other faculties such as Medical and engineering. Presently M Phil & Ph D program is being run by the faculty of General Studies.

BUP promises to provide the best possible congenial academic atmosphere and to complete the program within the stipulated time. It is also the only educational entity in the country where there is an opportunity of blending between civil students, professionals and member of armed forces with diversified skills, exposure experiences and outlook. BUP is working on setting up Language Centre and courses on Tourism, Nuclear Science and Engineering, Disaster Management and Climate Change related program.

The University has planned to establish a full fledged language centre from 1st July 2013 at the BUP Academic Building and later on it will ultimately turn in to a Language Institute. As a part of preparation and to build up the confidence, the University would like to start Introductory Certificate Course on Chinese and Burmese Language with a duration of 03 months (56 hours which is a 4 credit courses). These credits will be counted in future when this University will start a diploma/graduation program on language course. The outcome of this short course would be to understand sentences, becoming familiar with everyday expressions and very basic phrases of the languages. The short courses for other language will also be conducted such as the French, Russian, Chinese, Burmese, Arabic and Indians (Meghalayan, Assamese, Tripura and Mizo) etc. The importance of Chinese and Burmese Courses are as follows:

Importance of Chinese Course. Presently, Chinese being the second largest economy in the world has become a major player in the world economy and the demand for experienced professionals with Chinese language skills has also increased very dramatically. Learning Chinese language will provide you with an excellent chance to step into the job market and easily able to draw the attention of the future employers.

China is a huge export market not in the USA but it has got World wide business. Since, Chinese speakers are not only living in China, Taiwan and Singapore but they have also spread out through out Southeast Asia, North America and Europe where the Chinese communities congregate. As China is replacing the US as the main trading partner of most East and Southeast Asian countries and also dominates the economics of many countries in Asia, therefore, speaking Mandarin will give you an edge in doing business with those countries. Learning Chinese language will give a student, competitive advance as it is the

fastest growing foreign Language and also spreading in USA and Japan very rapidly. As China is widely regarded as the potentially biggest global market in the 21st century as such proficient speakers will find job opportunity in the various fields like business, government, International relations, Information Technology, tourism, education and interpretation etc.

Importance of Burmese Language Course. Myanmar is one of our neighbouring countries. The transit facility that we will have within very short span of time with Myanmar will facilitate to develop our trade. Bangladesh also needs to establish communication with Myanmar in order to improve upon bi-lateral issues that are yet to be resolved. So, learning Burmese language is very important for the people of all corners of Bangladesh etc.

- Chinese and Burmese Language: 04 September 2011 - 04 December 2011.
- English and French Language: 01 January 2012 - 31 March 2012.
- Chinese and English Language: 22 April 2012 - 22 July 2012.
