MoU Signed Between Department of Accounting and Information Systems and ICMAB

Under this MoU, ICMAB will:

- Offer tuition waivers to eligible AIS students.
- Extend necessary support to promote excellence in accounting education, research, and training.

This collaboration is intended to create a platform for mutual learning, joint initiatives, student development, and knowledge-sharing. Both institutions expressed strong commitment to working together to enhance the academic and professional landscape of accounting and finance education in Bangladesh.
