

Dhaka Bank PLC Holds Campus Recruitment Viva at BUP for Management Trainee Officer and Trainee Officer Positions

Dhaka, 02 September 2026: Dhaka Bank PLC conducted a campus recruitment viva examination for the positions of Management Trainee Officer (MTO) and Trainee Officer (TO) at Bangladesh University of Professionals (BUP) on 02 September 2026.
