4th BUP Convocation held at BUP



The 4th convocation of Bangladesh University of Professionals (BUP) was held on 26 December 2017 at BUP Playground of its campus. The Chairman of the convocation was the Chancellor of the University and the Honorable President of the People's Republic of Bangladesh, Mr. Md. Later, the Honorable President inaugurated the Bangabandhu Chair established at Centre for Higher Studies and Research (CHSR), BUP where the research on Bangladesh Studies and the life & works of Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman will be conducted.

Bangladesh University of Professionals (BUP) organized a discussion meeting titled “The Historic 7th March Speech of the Father of the Nation Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman” on 13 November 2017 at Bijoy Auditorium. The discussion meeting was arranged for the acknowledgement of the historic speech by Bangabandhu as ‘National Memory of the World’ from UNESCO and as ‘Poet of Politics’ from Newsweek Magazine. Noted that, at one stage of the long-running uncompromising movement on 07 March 1971, the undisputed leader and the greatest Bangali of the thousand years, Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman proclaimed for freedom in a thunderous voice at a mammoth rally at the Racecourse Maidan (now Suhrawardy Udyan). “Ebarer sangram amader muktir sangram, ebarer sangram swadhinatar sangram [The struggle this time is a struggle for emancipation, the struggle this time is a struggle for independence],”- This enlightened declaration of Bangabandhu was, in fact, the basis of our independence.

The speech of Bangabandhu has been included on 30 October 2017 in the Memory of the World International Register, a list of world’s important documentary heritage maintained by (United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization) UNESCO. Professor Emeritus Dr A K Azad Chowdhury, Former Chairman (State Minister) UGC and former vice chancellor of Dhaka University was present as the Chief Guest and BUP VC Major General Md Salahuddin Miaji, rcds, psc was present as the Special Guest. The Dean of Centre for Higher Studies and Research (CHSR) Brigadier General Syed Mofazzel Mawla (Retd) delivered the welcome speech in the programme. Chief of Army Staff Visits BUP

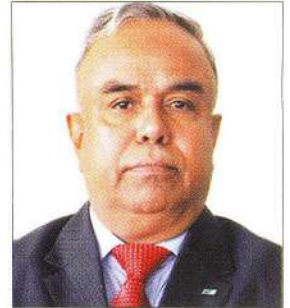

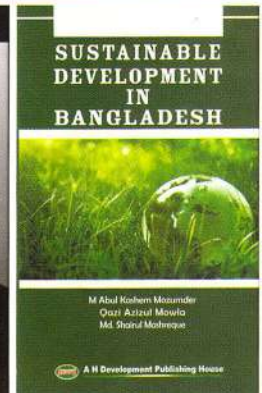
VC's Dorbar
