So we have to imbibe this spirit in our mind and have to contribute to make it as the Sonar Bangla of Bangabandhu.

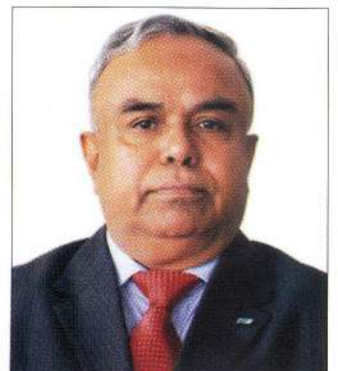
Inauguration of language Course
