For topping in three army level courses Major General Moshfeq is also awarded with the Army Medal of Excellence (SUP). He holds Masters Degrees in Defense, Security and Strategic Studies from the National University of Bangladesh, Bangladesh University of Professionals and Madras University in India respectively.

Bangladesh University of Professionals (BUP) celebrated the victory day with due dignity and enthusiasm. The national flag was hoisted at the BUP

building at sunrise on 16 December 2020 and three short films titled 'Amader Bangabandhu', 'Amader Muktiyuddho' and 'Sadhinata Amar Sadhinata' were screened at Bijoy Auditorium of BUP maintaining social distance. The inauguration of Comprehensive Learning Management System (CLMS), Remote Proctoring and Plagiarism Checker was held on 24 November 2020 maintaining social distancing at Bijoy Auditorium of Bangladesh University of Professionals (BUP). BUP has introduced this software to make the online BUP education programme more up-to-date and to conduct online classes smoothly amid any kind of global adverse situation like corona. The software enables to conduct online classes, exchange information between teachers and students, report on overall academic progress of the students, manage each teacher and student profile, upload videos, take any kind of exams and manage it by remote proctoring. It also will verify the originality and clarity of writing like thesis, term paper and assignment through 'Turn it in' plagiarism checker app. Moreover, this new platform will help to conduct academic activities related to education and research. In the inaugural ceremony, Hon'ble Minister of Education Dr. Dipu Moni, MP, Government of the People's Republic of Bangladesh, Ministry of Education was present as the chief guest and Hon'ble Deputy Minister of Education Mr. Mohibul Hasan Chowdhury, MP, Government of People's Republic of Bangladesh, Ministry of Education was present as the special guest. The former VC of BUP Major General Ataul Hakim Sarwar Hasan, SBP, SGP, ndc, afwc, psc, PhD (Now Lieutenant General) supervised the overall programme. The chief guest said in his speech that while Corona has ruined everything around the world, pushed education towards an extreme uncertainty, right there BUP has set an unique precedent. In the midst of this global stagnation, BUP has been using technology from the very beginning to conduct online classes, examinations and all other administrative activities. Inauguration of 5KW Vertical Wind Turbine "ONUVA"



The inaugural ceremony of 5KW Vertical Wind Turbine "ONUVA" was held at Bangladesh University of Professionals (BUP) on 23 November 2020 at the western side of BUP Plaza. Vertical Wind Turbine "ONUVA" is a step forward in achieving the goal of renewable power supply by using nature's wind energy through tolerant structures by reducing energy dependence. Hon'ble State Minister, Ministry of Power, Energy and Mineral Resource, Mr. Nasrul Hamid, MP was present as the chief guest at the inaugural function. The chief guest in his speech said that we are moving towards fulfilling our Vision 2021 even amid this global pandemic. In the meantime, we are working vehemently to increase the supply of electricity among all the people in the country, import liquefied natural gas to meet the energy demand, distribute residential solar systems and increase gas production. He specifically mentioned that this innovative technology of bio power generation of BUP will definitely play an important role in making us self-reliant. The Hon'ble State Minister also thanked the Vice-Chancellor of BUP and all those involved in the research under his leadership and encouraged further research. At the same time, he mentioned that the government of Bangladesh under the leadership of his ministry and the Hon'ble Prime Minister would come forward to take such research to go ahead. It is noted that the hybrid vertical turbine is made by combining the automatic braking system with the design of a completely fancy blade with indigenous technology and products. This innovation is presented alongside the Australian government's intellectual property company IP Australia. IP Australia awarded the invention as an Innovation Patent to the former Vice Chancellor of BUP Major General Ataul Hakim Sarwar Hasan, SBP, SGP, ndc, afwc, psc, PhD, (Now Lieutenant General), Assistant Professor Md. Rajib Uddin and affiliated institution SIGAS Bangladesh on 16 September 2020. By well-planned practical use of the patent will certainly make a significant contribution to the industry, rural and coastal areas. Among others, Hon'ble members of Parliament, secretaries of various ministries, high officials of BUP and media personnel were also present.

Webinar on "Proposed Bangladesh Land Act 2020 and Expert's Opinion"

Bangladesh University of Professionals Law and Moot Court Club (BUPLMCC) arranged a webinar titled "Proposed Bangladesh Land Act 2020 and Expert's Opinion" on 03 October 2020 in a virtual environment. Barrister M Amir-ul Islam, Senior Advocate at Supreme Court of Bangladesh and author of the proclamation of independence of Bangladesh, Prof. Dr. Biswajit Chanda, Member of University Grants Commission and Founding Chairman of Department of Law and Land Administration, University of Rajshahi and Dr. Masum Billah, Associate Professor of Jagannath University joined the webinar as panelists. Barrister M. Amir-ul Islam emphasized on the proper training of the adjudicators of land tribunals. He further recommended to design a mechanism of co-operation between judiciary and local administration. Dr. Masum Billah critically appraised the proposed Act. He also urged Law Commission to synchronize the provisions of the



proposed Act with the existing statutes in order to eliminate the loopholes. Prof. Biswajit Chanda highlighted the challenges of shifting the jurisdiction of trying land disputes from judiciary to executive branch. Md. Abu Hanif,

Lecturer in Law of BUP and Moderator of BUPLMCC commenced the webinar with his opening speech and Lieutenant Colonel Siraj Uddin Ahmed, psc (Retd), Chairman at the Department of Law, BUP concluded the webinar with closing speech and vote of thanks to the distinguished guests. The webinar was hosted by Zayed Bin Naser, General Member at BUPLMCC. Among others, students from the Department of Law also joined the webinar.

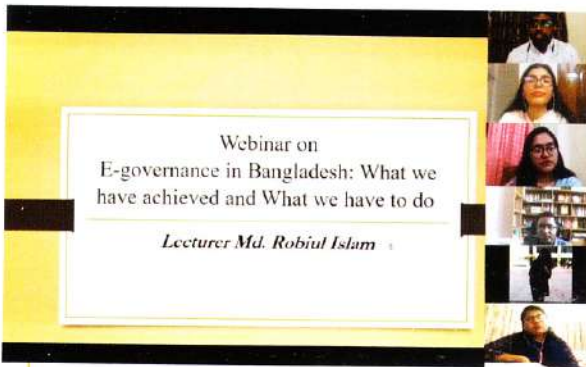
Achievement of 'SUP' Medal

'E-governance in Bangladesh: What we have achieved & what we have to do'



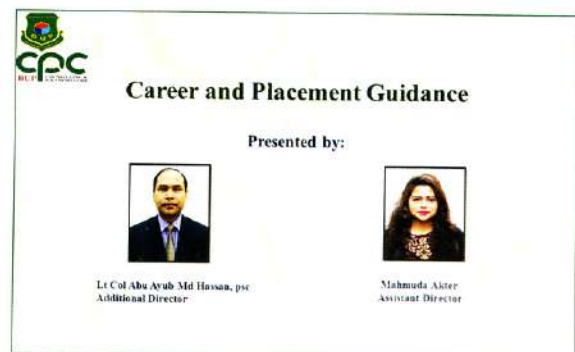

Webinar on "Constitution Day Celebration: Constitutional Tort in Bangladesh - Challenges and Prospects"

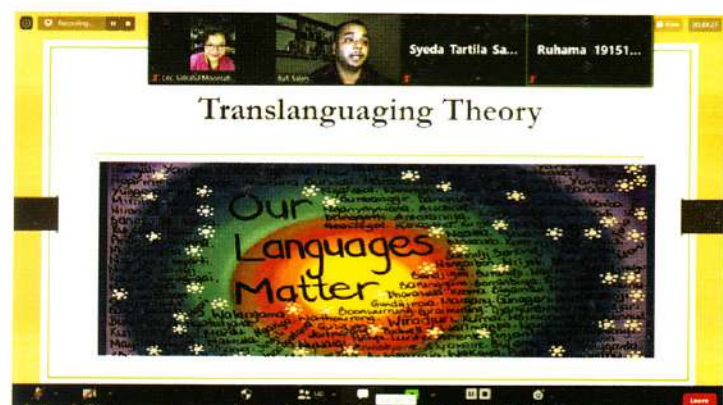


BUP Law and Moot Court Club (BUPLMCC) hosted a webinar titled "Constitution Day Celebration: Constitutional Tort in Bangladesh - Challenges and Prospects" to observe the Constitution Day of the Bangladesh which took place on 4 November 2020. BUPLMCC organized the webinar in honour

of our constitution which has immense significance in every sphere of our socio-political life and its enactment is a vital part of the history of Bangladesh. Justice M A Matin, Former Judge at Appellate Division of the Supreme Court of Bangladesh and Advocate Arif Khan, Senior Lawyer, the Supreme Court of Bangladesh and Director of Bangladesh Institute for Constitution Studies were present as panellists of the webinar. At the beginning of the webinar Justice Matin briefly discussed the history and transformation of constitutional Tort and its integration into our legal system. He emphasized on the development of the method to bring constitutional tort within the periphery of constitutional law issues. The speakers admitted about the pressing need for codified tort law in our country and suggested the Law Commission of Bangladesh to take necessary initiatives to provide a comprehensive framework for tort in Bangladesh. Lieutenant Colonel Siraj Uddin Ahmed, psc (Retd), Chairman, Department of Law, Bangladesh University of Professionals concluded the webinar with closing speech and vote of thanks to the distinguished guests.
