I am sure that the newsletter will become a must-read chronicle on happenings around us. I congratulate editorial team for their initiative and wish them success.











BUP Observes National Mourning Day 2021



'Pandemic and Plights of the Returnee Migrant Workers of Bangladesh: Bangabandhu's Vision, Achievement & Way Forward'



The pandemic of COVID-19 posed a serious threat to migrant workers all over the world. Migrant workers from Bangladesh, for example, were among the worst sufferers. The pandemic created a two-sided challenge: one for workers who had to return from various nations fearing to be unable of finding work in the near future, and another for the workers who became stranded abroad with little to no protection or rights. On 23 August 2021, the Department of Law of Bangladesh University of Professionals (BUP) has organized a webinar on the plights of returnee migrant workers of Bangladesh through the lens of Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman's political philosophy.

Mr. Imran Ahmed, MP, Honorable Minister, Ministry of Expatriates' Welfare and Overseas Employment, Government of the People's Republic of Bangladesh graced the occasion as the chief guest of the Webinar. 




'Rising Teen Gang-Culture and Violence in Bangladesh: Revisiting Juvenile Delinquency from Sociological Lens'

Honours First Year Admission

TEST

Bangladesh University of Professionals (BUP) has conducted Honours Admission Test on 20 and 21 August 2021. Due to the ongoing pandemic, the admission tests were conducted both in Dhaka and outside Dhaka maintaining social distancing and Covid-19 health protocols. Three centres outside Dhaka were Bogura, Chattogram and Khulna.

On 20 August, the admission test of Faculty Science and Technology (FST) and Faculty Arts and Social Sciences (FASS) were held in the morning and afternoon respectively while the tests of Faculty of Security and Strategic Studies (FSSS) and Faculty of Business Administration (FBS) were held on 21 August.

This year, more than 77,000 candidates took part the tests against 1,250 seats. BUP is the first public university who conducted admission test amid the ongoing pandemic. Almost 80% students were present in the admission test. There was an excitement among the students and parents regarding the admission test. The initiave of BUP to conduct admission test physically maintaining social distancing and covid-19 protocols were much appreciated by all.







BUP in Competition organized by BNCC

Bangladesh National Cadet Corps (BNCC) is working to build the student community as a patriotic and conscious citizen. 


