EVENTS

16th Senate Meeting



The 16th Annual Senate Meeting of Bangladesh University of Professionals (BUP) was held on 10 June 2024 at Bijoy Auditorium of BUP. Vice Chancellor, BUP and Senate Chairman Major General Md Mahbub-ul Alam, BSP, ndc, afwc, psc, MPhil, PhD presided over the meeting.

At the beginning of the meeting, BUP Vice Chancellor and Senate Chairman Major General Md Mahbub-ul Alam thanked the outgoing members and welcomed the newly appointed members. Later, BUP Treasurer Air Commodore Md Shafiqul Islam, ndc, fawc, psc, GD(P) put the revised 2023-2024 fiscal year budget amounting to Tk. 129 Crore 7 lac and announced an amount of Tk. 132 Crore 93 lac budget for the fiscal year 2024-2025 which was unanimously approved by the Senate Members. Besides, the 16th Annual Report was presented in the Senate Meeting which was also unanimously approved by the Senate Members. The meeting was conducted by the Registrar of BUP A B M Faisal Baten, ndc, psc.

The Vice Chancellor, BUP and the Senate Chairman Major General Md Mahbub-ul Alam said, at the beginning of his speech, that the generation of new knowledge, expansion of educational and research programmes, development of various infrastructure and other multifaceted activities are ongoing in BUP. The University has already formulated a comprehensive 'Academic Strategic Plan 2023-2050' and its implementation will assist in achieving its goals both at national and international level. He further informed that various co-curricular and extracurricular activities are conducted through 27 clubs of BUP for developing timely skills among the students with a goal to enhancing their innovative ideas and creativity. Besides, he opined that BUP emphasizes on inculcating moral values and awakening patriotism among the new generation. He particularly mentioned that BUP Research Centre is carrying out large-scale research activities. In addition, BUP publishing 5 research journals, with the objective of disseminating research-based knowledge and skills for faculties and students with utmost importance. The Vice Chancellor of BUP also informed about the activities of the Office of International Affairs which aimed at exposing the university in the international arena, especially in higher education, research, admission of foreign students and introducing BUP to the researchers and teachers of foreign universities. The Vice-Chancellor further informed everyone that at present BUP admission process including application, registration, and final admission is fully automated. He also informed that evaluation of Faculty Members is being conducted through Students Evaluation System in all the courses which is also bridging the gap between teachers and students.

Among the Senate Members, notably Major (Retd) Rafiqul Islam (Bir Uttam), MP, Mohammad Abdur Razzaque, MP, Mr. Nurul Islam Nahid, MP, Mr. Md. Shahriar Alam, MP, Major General (Retd) Salahuddin Miazi, MP, Secretaries from different ministries, high officials from Bangladesh Armed Forces, and high officials of BUP were present in the meeting.



Freshers' Reception 2023-2024



The Freshers' Reception 2023-2024 for the newly enrolled students at Bangladesh University of Professionals (BUP) was held at BUP Campus on 02 May 2024. The Vice Chancellor Major General Md Mahbub-ul Alam, BSP, ndc, afwc, psc, MPhil, PhD was present on the occasion as the Chief Guest. This year over 200 teams consisting of around 850 HR enthusiasts from various reputed universities participated in the competition and demonstrated their HR knowledge and skills. At least 24 teams advanced to the semi-final round where they presented solutions to HR challenges and participated in debates. 


Orientation Programme of 'Inflow 2024'

CONFERENCE/SEMINAR/WORKSHOP

Climate Change, Gender and Environmental Justice: Bangladesh Perspective



The Department of Sociology, under the Faculty of Arts and Social Sciences (FASS), recently held a seminar titled 'Climate Change, Gender, and Environmental Justice: Bangladesh Perspective' on 22 April 2024, at Bijoy Auditorium. The keynote paper was presented by notable scholar Professor Dr. Mahbuba Nasreen, the Pro Vice Chancellor of Bangladesh Open University, Her insights, along with contributions from Assistant Professor Saiful Islam and Lecturer Tanvir Mahtab, sparked meaningful discussions on climate change and gender dynamics in Bangladesh. 


