• **Candidates with O/A Level:**

Candidates must have a minimum average grade point of 2.5 in GCE O-Level (with minimum 05 Courses) and 2.0 in GCE A-Level (with minimum 02 Courses) with a bachelor's degree to apply for the LLM (Professional) program. Letter grades of O-Level and A-Level subjects are converted to grade points as A\*/A = 5, B= 4, C = 3.5, D=3. For any foreign degree, candidate must have equivalence certificate from the concerned authorities.
